INFORMATION AND RULES FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE EXHIBITION OF CHILDREN DRAWINGS: "CHILDREN IN REINDEER HUSBANDRY - 2017"

Responsible organizer:

Responsible organizer is the secretariat of the Association of World Reindeer Herders (WRH). The exhibition is organized in connection with the 6th World Reindeer Herders' Congress in Jokkmokk, 16th – 20th August 2017.

Who can participate?

Children and youth up to 17 years in the different reindeer herding regions all over the circumpolar Arctic can participate in the exhibition with their own drawings.

Theme

The theme for the exhibition is "Children in reindeer husbandry - 2017". We want drawings showing reindeer husbandry, seen with the children's eyes. It is up to each participant to choose what to draw as long it is something connected to reindeer husbandry. A participant can participate with several drawings.

Requirements

The drawings can be all from pencil drawings to watercolor paintings, wood- or linocut, oil paintings etc. The minimum size of the drawings should be at least A4 (21x30cm) format and maximum 4 times A4 size. The drawings should not be framed.

The name, age, place, region and country of the artist must be written down on the left or right side on the bottom of the drawing. (*For example; Ivan V. Galkin, 4 years, Lovozero, Murmansk Oblast, Russia*). Name of school, kindergarten or reindeer herding unit/brigade can be written on the drawing if desirable. A title might also be written on the drawing but it is not required.

Rewards

Ten of those who send drawing(s) to the exhibition will be rewarded with a small gift by drawing lots among all participants. WRH's executive board will draw the lots after the Congress. All participants will receive a diploma confirming their participation in the exhibition.

Rights, exhibition and publishing

All received drawings are regarded as the property of WRH, and will be stored at the secretariat of WRH. All drawings will be displayed at the exhibition "Children in reindeer husbandry – 2017" during the 6th World Reindeer Herders' Congress in Jokkmokk, Sweden, 16th – 20th August 2017. WRH reserves the rights to exhibit the drawings in the future in WRHs offices and during different events of WRH. WRH also reserves the right to select drawings to be included in a book "Children of reindeer 2017", which is planned to be printed and released after the Congress. Any possible income from the sale of the book will be included in WRHs work with children and youth in reindeer husbandry.

Deadline, where to send the drawings etc

The drawings to the exhibition can be sent to the following mailing address: WRH, P.O. Box 109, N-9521 Kautokeino, Norway. Only original drawings will be accepted. Full name and mailing address plus information required under the point "Requirements", is required in order to accept the drawing(s) in the exhibition.

Drawing(s) sent by ordinary mail need to be at WRH no later than 1st August 2017. Delegates to the Congress from different regions can bring with them the drawings from their regions. Drawings brought by the delegates are guaranteed to be displayed at the exhibition.
