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Introduction

Reindeer herding is the primary livelihood for over 24 indigenous peoples in the 15 circumpolar north and involves close to 100,000 indigenous peoples and about 16.25 million domestic reindeer (Degteva et al., 2017). The climate changes are now evident in the traditional reindeer herding areas in the circumpolar north (Eira, et al 2018) (ch. 2, 7, 18 and 8). Sámi reindeer husbandry represents a livelihood and way of life based on practices and knowledge developed through long-term experiences in living under harsh and highly variable conditions in the arctic environment.

Sustainability of Sámi reindeer husbandry faces major challenges related to rapid changes in the reindeer pasture areas such as climate change and loss of grazing land. These kinds of challenges have recently been lifted in COP27 in Sharm el-Sheikh. The Rievdan research project has investigated opportunities for Sámi reindeer herders to adapt to these challenges using their own reindeer herding knowledge. The research project was based on and according to goals and strategies set by Sámi University of Applied Sciences and goals by international Centre for Reindeer husbandry. The goal of the research project was to provide a knowledge base for a new master's program in reindeer husbandry, to explain the tensions between two knowledge systems with different approaches to reindeer husbandry: Traditional knowledge and Research-based knowledge, to contribute to new knowledge and understanding to increase the sustainability of reindeer husbandry, and to find forms of cooperation between the various knowledge systems. The Rievdan project is about the reconciliation of the traditional knowledge of reindeer husbandry and the Western knowledge in a changing world. This project, through the multidisciplinary approaches, resulted in a number of peer-reviewed scientific articles, books on traditional knowledge, and international reports. Two peer-reviewed books in Springer Nature Polar Series are published/in production along with one thematic issue of the *Dieđut* on the Arctic Indigenous Peoples' food systems. By this, the project has provided a knowledge base for a new Master's degree Program in Reindeer Husbandry Studies. The results of the project show opportunities and capabilities embedded in traditional knowledge and scientific knowledge with focus on adaptation to change and reconciliation, and the pathway to sustainable reindeer husbandry is using two ways of knowing. The project has combined the question of how Sámi reindeer herders adapt to adverse and changing weather conditions with the epistemological question of how to bring together and integrate the two different knowledge-domains of a) the knowledge and practice of traditional reindeer herding and b) the knowledge and practice of modern science and public management. The traditional knowledge is a source of resilience that could mitigate the risks of future disasters. The project has made reindeer herding knowledge more visible and respected.

The Rievdan project

The Research Council of Norway granted the project in the program Strategic University Projects (SHP) in 2015. The project manager was Sámi University of Applied Sciences with the cooperation partners International Centre of Reindeer husbandry (ICR) and Association of World Reindeer Herders. ICR confirmed active participation in the development and implementation in the project, in accordance with the project description including work efforts from their staff, including the Executive Director and our Scientific Advisors. ICRs participation in the Rievdan project is seen as part of the UArctic EALÁT Institute at ICR, as well as our initiative Arctic Indigenous Peoples' Culinary Institute.

This research design, and the way it elaborated show substantial innovation in the way we understand both the role traditional knowledge and practices can play in the future of Sami livelihoods in the Arctic and what the challenges may be in combining this traditional knowledge and practice with modern science-based public management strategies.

The project have combined the question of how Sámi reindeer herders adapt to adverse and changing weather conditions with the epistemological question of how one can bring together and integrate the two different knowledge-domains of a) the knowledge and practice of traditional reindeer herding and b) the knowledge and practice of modern science and public management.

Although the project have been working through 4 working packages, WP1 and WP3 hhave had close cooperation and collaboration;

- Work package 1: Basic understanding of what sustainable Sami reindeer husbandry entails.
- Work package 2: Legal status of reindeer husbandry in a changing world.
- Work package 3: Traditional knowledge of food culture - navigation towards future sustainability - two ways of knowing?
- Work package 4: Summarise, discuss, and communicate findings.

Result information

The project has contributed to scientific innovation as well as generating new knowledge. The interdisciplinary scope of the project has been significant. The combination of interdisciplinary cooperation with participants with specialisations in reindeer husbandry, meteorology, climate change, biology, and Sámi culture and society have also been significant. These have provided publications in recognized scientific journals in the fields and also provided insights for other communities whose economic activity is under environmental threat. This has provided important

results in the context of environmental and economic change and associated threats to indigenous knowledge and practices.

The plan to use the project to have as an outcome for the establishment of a knowledge base for an interdisciplinary Master's program in reindeer herding has been essential. In 2016 the Rievdan project group under the auspices of Sámi University of Applied Sciences developed and sent application NOKUT for accreditation of a two-year program in Master of Science in Sustainable Reindeer Husbandry (120 ECTS credits). The subject of Sustainable Reindeer Husbandry itself requires such a multidisciplinary approach. The situation of reindeer husbandry in regard to sustainability is so pressing that it is necessary to consider all available sources of knowledge in order to cope with the existing and arising challenges. The content of the program, including these courses, is nested within several international research projects and networks as will be described further below.

1. Philosophy of science, methodology and research ethics
2. Knowledge Foundations for Sustainable Reindeer Husbandry
3. Reindeer herders' food and their social-ecological food system in a changing Arctic
4. Adaptation, vulnerability, and resilience in reindeer husbandry to climate change
5. The legal protection of reindeer husbandry from an international and national perspective and a customary law based understanding of reindeer herders own rights
6. Governance in and of Reindeer Pastoralism
7. Economic organization, markets and innovation from a reindeer husbandry perspective.
8. Siiddastallan, Land-use and mapping
9. Master thesis writing (including final exam and seminar)

Furthermore, the results show that the loss of grazing areas combined with the effect of increased air temperature challenges the indigenous people economically and their cultural practices (Springer chapters 3 and 9). Reindeer management should therefore develop its own adaptation strategies (Springer chapters 2 and 5) where the value of traditional knowledge is recognized and where reindeer management knowledge is used actively in management and control (Springer chapter 4). It is important that all available forms of knowledge are considered in the development of reindeer husbandry's adaptation strategies (Springer chapters 2 and 6). In Norway, there are barriers to the use of traditional knowledge for nature management and in the development of reindeer husbandry, which must be resolved (Springer ch. 3). Adaptation to future climate change in reindeer herding areas requires training of young reindeer herders linked to long-term sustainable thinking, which should include a future Master's program in reindeer herding (Springer chapters 2, 5 and 6). Protection of reindeer pastures is the most important adaptation strategy during the ongoing climate changes

(Springer chapters 2 and 9). Much of this knowledge disappears if it is not documented and used (Springer ch. 3, 5 and 6). We propose a new approach to the sustainability of reindeer husbandry, where we define reindeer husbandry's limitations and opportunities based on traditional knowledge (Springer chapter 4). We have identified several limitations that are important for future reindeer husbandry with a focus on adaptability (Springer ch. 2 and 3). The use of Sami snow terms reflects the reindeer herders' traditional knowledge of the management of the herd on snow-covered land and how the shepherds handle these complex systems (Springer chapters 3 and 4). It is important that we now do everything to increase the adaptability of reindeer husbandry to the effects of global warming so that reindeer husbandry remains an ecologically and economically robust civilization in the future as well (Springer chapter 10). Erosion of the knowledge base for reindeer herding may have affected reindeer herding's vulnerability to change (Springer Chapter 4). It is therefore important to build a bridge between academia and indigenous communities so that the adaptation strategies follow Arctic realities (Springer chapters 2, 3 and 5). The environment, climate and biodiversity are changing in the Circumpolar North in ways unique to the region's long history, challenging traditional lifestyles, well-being, food security and posing a legitimate concern for the future of traditional indigenous economies (Springer Chapters 7, 8 and 9) . The Reindeer Husbandry Springer book analyses adaptation to changes that are essential for reindeer husbandry in future
